Footnote:-

The session will end with a time of relaxation and discussion, and refreshments.

The aim is to learn a little more about <u>active listening skills</u> and to seek out 'best practice' in any pastoral care role or situation.

In order to achieve this, it is necessary to find out a little more about yourself, which can sometimes be a little painful. However, the course will be run in a safe and secure environment with each member of the course looking out for everyone else.
